- 2. Protect yourself by locking your vehicles anytime, and anywhere they are parked. Do not store valuables in plain view inside your vehicles including cell phones, GPS, tools, wallets, change etc.
- 3. Even if nothing went missing, but someone entered your vehicle and searched through it, be sure to report it to the police.
