OPP charge driver, speeding twice the legal limit

On Saturday March 21, 2015 Dufferin OPP officers were conducting Moving Radar enforcement on Dufferin County Rd. #17 in Melancthon Township. They observed an eastbound vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed. The vehicle was clocked at 162 km/hr in a posted 80 km/hr zone which is twice the legal speed limit.

A traffic stop was conducted and an 18 year old male driver from Amaranth was charged with Race Motor Vehicle? Perform Stunt? Excessive speed contrary to the Highway Traffic Act. His driver's license and vehicle were seized for 7 days.

The driver will appear in Orangeville Court at a later date to answer to the charge. This incident is concerning because it occurred in later part of the local distracted driving campaign which was well publicized.
