

Driver and passengers charged at RIDE check

Just after midnight on Saturday July 6th officers observed a vehicle that appeared to be trying to avoid coming through a R.I.D.E. spot check. Officers began an investigation and stopped the Volkswagen Golf. The investigation resulted in all three male occupants being charged with various drug related and alcohol related offences: 27 year old Michael MacLeod of Owen Sound, 23 year old Zachary Bowen of Thorold and 38 year old Brandon Sanderson of Orangeville were arrested and charged with Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Psilocybin (known as magic mushrooms) as well as having open liquor in a motor vehicle. They were released on promise to appear with court dates in August.
