Police execute search warrant, lay cocaine trafficking charges]

Officers from the Dufferin Detachment of the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) seized a quantity of drugs and charged three individuals as a result of an ongoing drug investigation in Dufferin County.

On Tuesday (Mar. 21), members of the Dufferin Community Street Crime Unit (CSCU), with the assistance of Nottawasaga CSCU executed a search warrant at an address in the Town of Orangeville. Officers seized a quantity of Cocaine, Percocet tablets, drug paraphilia and \$1,300 in cash. In addition to the seizure, three individuals were arrested and charged with multiple offences.

In addition to the seizure, four people were charged with the following offences.

? Possession of proceeds of property obtained by crime - under \$5000
? Possession of property obtained by crime - under \$5000
Leanne CARLE, 53-year-old from Orangeville has been charged with:
? Possession of a Schedule I Substance for the purpose of Trafficking - Cocaine
Richard EVANS, 29-year-old from Orangeville has been charged with:
? Possession of a Schedule I Substance for the purpose of Trafficking - Cocaine
All three accused are scheduled to attend the Ontario Court of Justice in Orangeville at a future date in April 2023, to answer to their charges.
