

Impaired driving, cannabis possession charges laid

Dufferin OPP charged a 37 year old Toronto man with multiple offenses after a traffic stop.

On Feb. 15 Dufferin police were patrolling the area of County Road 109 in Orangeville when a traffic stop lead officers to question a driver's ability to operate their vehicle. He was subsequently arrested and a search of the vehicle resulted in cannabis being seized. He faces charges for:

- ? Operation while impaired- alcohol and drugs
- ? Failure or refusal to comply with demand
- ? Operation While Prohibited under the Criminal Code
- ? Possession of over 30g dried cannabis in a public place
- ? Drive vehicle or boat with cannabis readily available
- ? Fail to surrender permit for motor vehicle
- ? Fail to surrender insurance card

The accused individual is scheduled to appear before the Ontario Court of Justice in Orangeville. None of the charges have been proven in court.
