

Tilson re-elected Chairman of Standing Committee on Citizenship & Immigration

David Tilson, Member of Parliament for Dufferin-Caledon, was re-elected as Chairman of the Standing Committee on Citizenship and Immigration on October 29, 2013.

Mr. Tilson was first elected to the Standing Committee on Citizenship and Immigration on February 3, 2009.
