

Hit the Road Dufferin!

For the 13th year in a row, motorcycle and car enthusiasts are invited to hit the road, on Sunday June 7th, in support of Hospice Dufferin.

‘We count on this event to generate the dollars needed to run critical programs like volunteer visiting and bereavement support,’ said Maureen Riedler, Executive Director of Hospice Dufferin. ‘We are so grateful to everyone who has participated over the years.’

Each year, Hospice Dufferin serves nearly 350 palliative care clients on a \$193,000 budget. The Central West Local Health Integration Network (LHIN) funds 25 per cent; for the remaining 75 per cent, Hospice Dufferin relies on donations from the community.

‘Hit The Road for Hospice has seen declining participation over the past few years,’ said Barb Hulse, Chair of Hospice’s Board of Directors, ‘We really need the support of all the local riders to help us achieve our fundraising goal of \$20,000 for this year’s event. Fortunately, Scotiabank and RBC have given us a great jump start towards our goal.’

Like in past years, motorcycles and cars can choose to participate in the Poker Run, or instead can join the guided Scenic Tour. The cost is only \$30 per person (or \$100 in pledges) and includes lunch. There are great cash prizes for the top Poker hands: \$500 for 1st, \$200 for 2nd, and \$100 for 3rd. Following the ride, all participants are invited to the Curling Club for a BBQ lunch, silent auction, raffle and prizes.

All participants must check-in at the Orangeville Curling Club between 9-10 a.m. Poker Run participants can depart immediately after checking-in. The guided Scenic Tour departs at 10:30 a.m.
