

What you need to know in the Town of Shelburne

The voting period for the 2026 Municipal Election runs from 10 a.m. on Friday, October 16, 2026 to 8 p.m. on Monday, October 26, 2026.

Voters in the Town of Shelburne will once again be able to cast their vote for mayor, deputy mayor, councillors, and school board trustee all from the comfort of their home, or anywhere they can access the internet or telephone 24 hours a day. The Election Centre will be available during the voting period to provide assistance.

To vote in a municipal election, you must be a Canadian citizen and at least 18 years old, be qualified to vote in the municipality by living in the municipality, or owning or renting property in the municipality, or being the spouse of somebody who owns or rents property in the municipality.
